The Parent Class Representative or Parent Rep provides an important line of communication between the classroom teacher and parents.

Your child's classroom teacher is asking for a parent or two, to nominate as the parent rep for the year.

The role of the parent rep is to;

- Forward information from the teacher to parents (school will give contact details)
- Forward information from the P&C to families in the class
- Assist the teacher in sourcing helpers for activities/excursions, if required
- Support parents, particularly new families, by advising on where to go or who to ask for information
- Encourage parents to get involved with school and P&C activities in some way, however small, throughout the year

The Parent rep role assists in encouraging involvement and contributions to our vibrant school community. There is no requirement for Parent Reps to attend P&C meetings, however all parents are encouraged and welcome to do so.

Some other activities that Parent reps can be involved with include (but not limited to);

- Passing on to the P&C any fundraising ideas and suggestions parents may have offered
- Planning social activities, e.g. parent coffee mornings, play dates after school, on weekends or during the holidays
