We look forward to the final assessment next week and are confident it will continue just as successfully. Credit also to all our amazing staff that have supported our students for these assessments, not just in the past few weeks of this term, but for all the learning that has occurred for students across the years which enables them to successfully participate in this National Assessment program.

### **Harmony Week**

Next week we will celebrate Harmony Week as a school community. Students are invited to wear an orange T-shirt or cultural dress on Friday 20 March, to recognise and celebrate the many diverse cultures that make up our wonderful school community. Harmony Week is a special opportunity to acknowledge that everyone belongs, and to celebrate the rich cultural diversity of Australia. If your child does not have an orange T-shirt or cultural dress, they are required to wear their school uniform, as this is not a free dress day.

### **Easter Raffle**

### **Kiss 'n' Drive Reminder**

In an effort to ensure the safety of our student, parents are reminded that there are approximately five bays at the front of the school on Brockmill Avenue designated as Kiss 'n' Drive bays. These bays commence at the school pedestrian gate and stretch Eastward to the vehicle entry gate. If you are using these bays, please use them as Kiss 'n' Drive bays by remaining your vehicle and waiting for your child to come to you. If you prefer to park and walk into the school to collect your child from class, please use the parking bays in Bray Place, along the roadside on Maguire Avenue, or along Brockmill Avenue on the opposite side of the road to the school. Additional roadside parking is also available on Brockmill Avenue beginning behind the Kiss 'n' Drive bays and extending westward along the road out the front of the playground area. Your assistance in following these arrangements helps us maintain safe traffic flow and keep our students safe.

### **Electric Bikes and Scooters**

The safety of our students is always our priority. Students are not permitted to ride electric bikes or electric scooters to school. These devices can travel at high speeds and require advanced road awareness and control skills that many primary-aged students are still developing. Our school also experiences significant pedestrian traffic before and after school, and the presence of high-speed devices can increase the risk of accidents or injury for both riders and other students. Additionally, there are limited secure storage options on site, which increases the risk of damage or theft.

We appreciate your support in reinforcing this expectation with your children and helping us maintain a safe environment for all members of our school community.

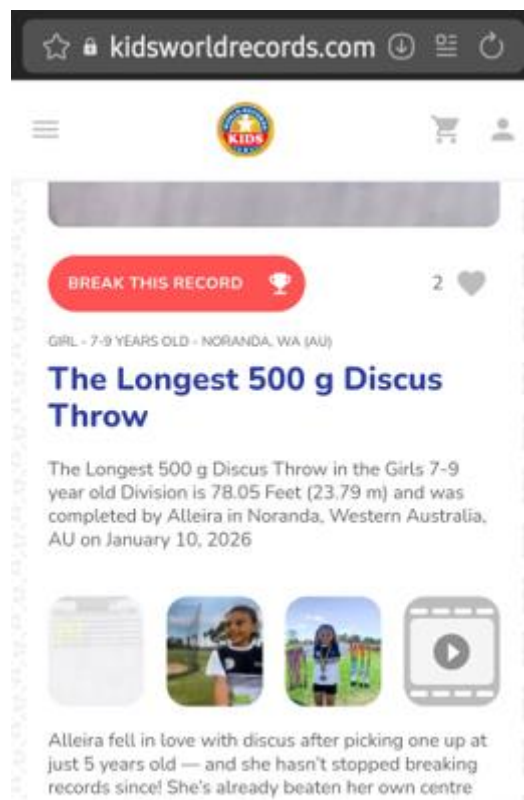
### ***Celebrating Student Achievement***

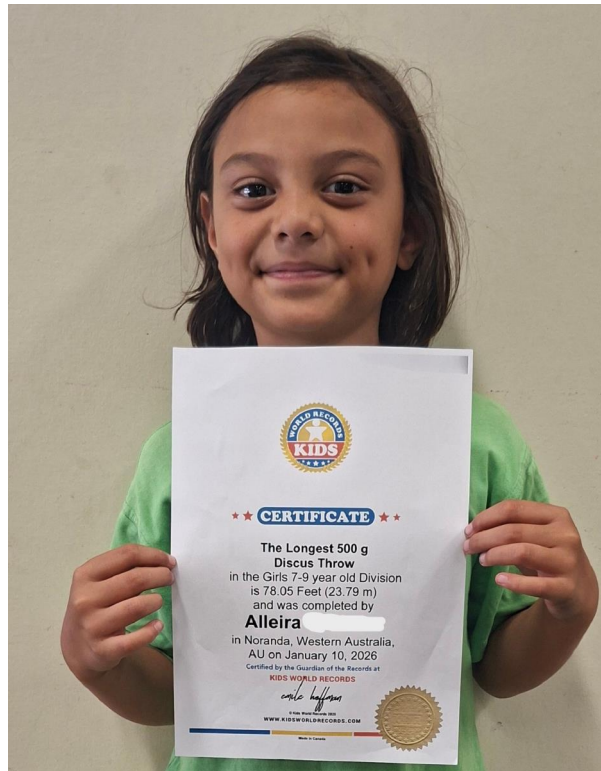
We are incredibly proud to share the outstanding sporting achievements of **Alleira W**, one of our talented Year 3 students. At just 7 years old, Alleira has recorded an impressive 23.79 metre throw in the 500g discus, surpassing the previous best distance of 23.36 metres, a mark that had stood since the late 1980s and early 1990s. Based on available international performance data, this result places Alleira among the top-performing 7-year-old discus athletes in the world.

Over the recent Christmas period, Alleira also broke several centre records, including one that had stood for over 50 years. More recently, she exceeded a 30-year-old record in the next age group, which is an exceptional achievement for such a young athlete.

Alleira trains with experienced athletics coaches who have been involved in Little Athletics and high-level competition for many years. They have commented on her impressive technique, coordination and determination, noting that she demonstrates skills and focus that are rarely seen in athletes her age. Alleira has set her sights on one day representing Australia in discus at the Olympic Games, a goal that reflects her passion for the sport and her commitment to continual improvement. Alongside her training, she continues to balance her sporting pursuits with her learning at school.

Alleira's achievements are a wonderful example of dedication, perseverance and goal setting, and we congratulate her on this amazing achievement. We look forward to watching her continue to develop her talents in the years ahead.

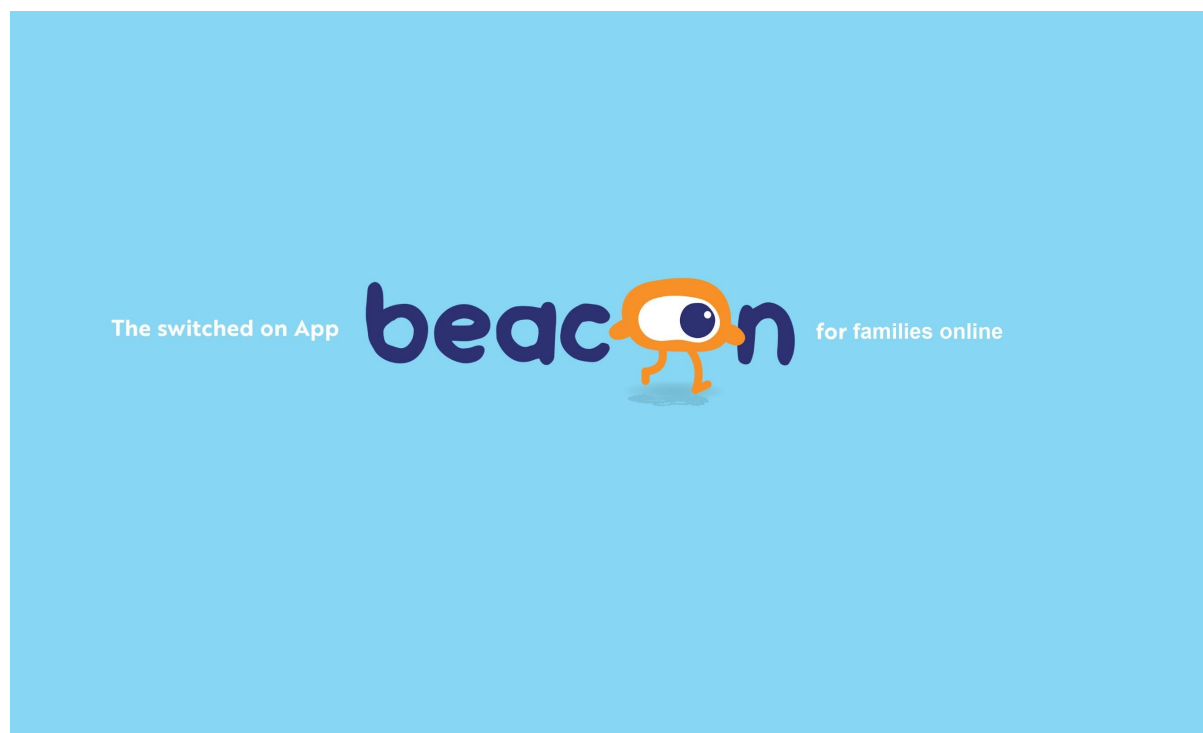

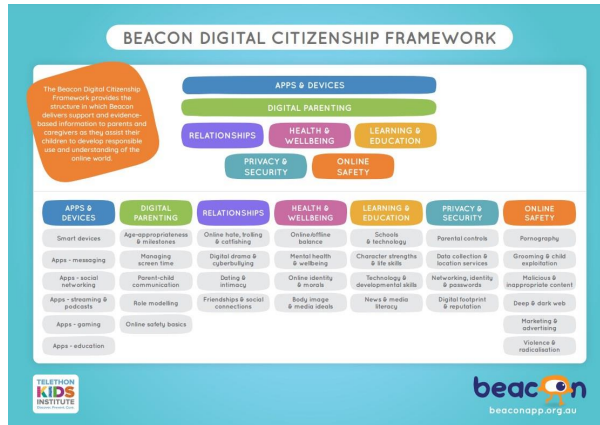

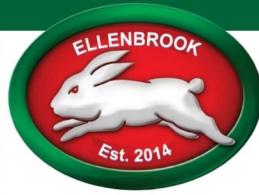
