Staffing Updates

I would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge several staff members who will be leaving us at the end of this term, as well as welcome new and familiar faces to our school community.

Miss Eliza Mast has been teaching in both Room 14 and Room 16 this term, and we sincerely thank her for her valuable contributions to our students and school. Miss Mast has successfully secured a full-time teaching position at Dianella Primary School commencing next term. We congratulate her on this achievement and wish her every success in her future career.

We are pleased to welcome Miss Kyra Coutinho, who will be teaching in Room 14 on Thursdays and Fridays. Miss Coutinho is well known to our school, having completed her final practicum with us last year and worked as a relief teacher this year.

We also warmly welcome Mr Corey Seymour to our staff. Mr Seymour is very familiar with our students and school, having worked with us in a relief capacity over the past few years. He will be teaching in Room 16 on Wednesdays while Mr Fairbairn undertakes his Deputy Principal responsibilities.

Additionally, I would like to inform our community that Pak G (Mr Glendinning), our much-loved Indonesian teacher, has made the significant decision to retire from his permanent

teaching position with the Department of Education. Pak G has been a long-serving and highly valued member of our staff, and we thank him for his dedication and contribution to our school over many years.

We are delighted that Pak G will continue to be part of our school community in a relief teaching capacity, and we wish him all the very best in this new chapter of his life. Mr Seymour will work Monday and Friday next term in Pak G's role whilst we run a process to employ a Languages teacher.

Important information on changes to Reporting Student Achievement

The Department of Education has recently made some changes to the way schools report student progress to families. End of semester written student reports will now include mode and strand reporting for Mathematics and English only, and overall grades for all other learning areas. Individual learning area comments will no longer be included; instead, there will be a single overall classroom comment.

To support these changes, schools are now able to include a reporting day in both Semester 1 and Semester 2. At East Beechboro Primary School, our Semester 1 reporting day will be **Friday, 5 June** (Week 7, Term 2). **On this day students will not attend school** and staff will be available for parent meetings. To support families requiring care, Camp Australia will be open for the day, and the booking system for this day is already available.

Parents will be able to book a ten minute meeting with their child's classroom teacher and a short meeting with the specialist teachers if required. Families will have access to an online booking system to schedule these appointments. Further information about how to book these meetings will be provided at the beginning of next term.

Before School Supervision Reminder

To support the safety and wellbeing of all students, we kindly remind families that students should not arrive at school before 8:15am. The undercover area will be closed until 8:15am, when staff supervision becomes available.

If you require care for your child prior to 8:15am, we encourage you to consider enrolling them in Camp Australia.

In the event of unforeseen circumstances where a student arrives before 8:15am and you have been unable to secure a place at Camp Australia, they should wait in the undercover area located at the back of the staffroom until supervision begins.

Thank you for your understanding and support in helping us maintain a safe environment for all students.

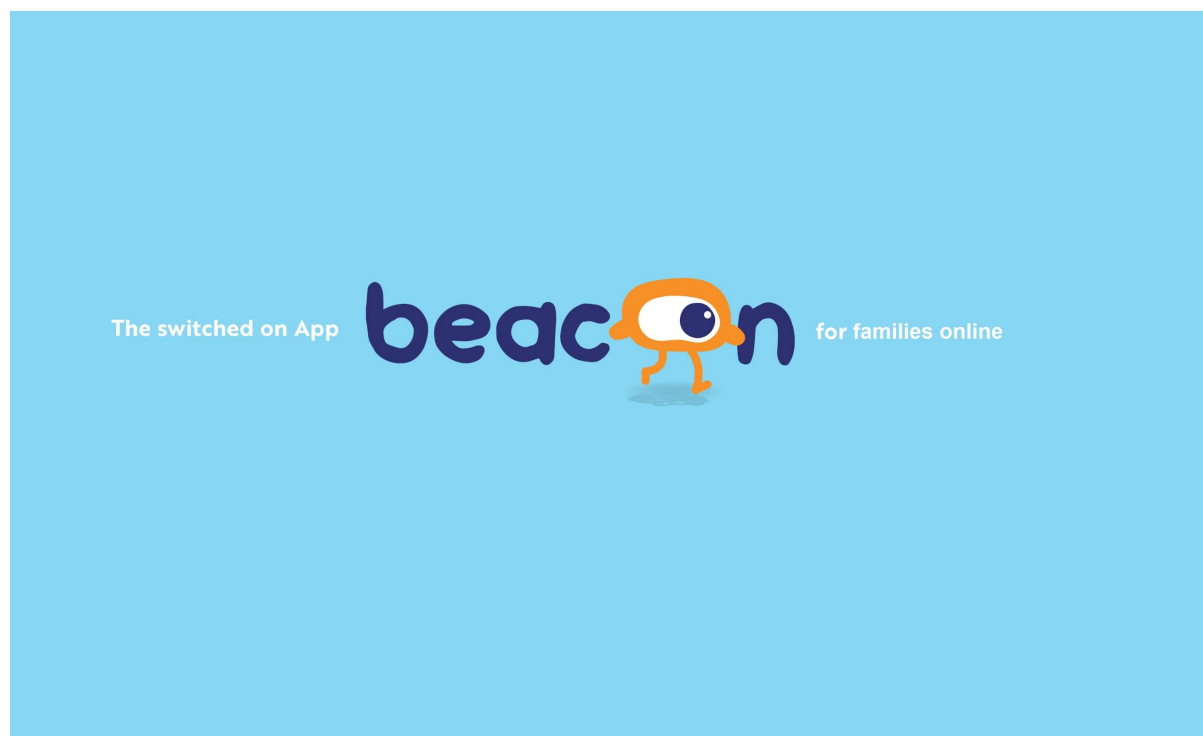

CYBER SAFETY APP FOR PARENTS

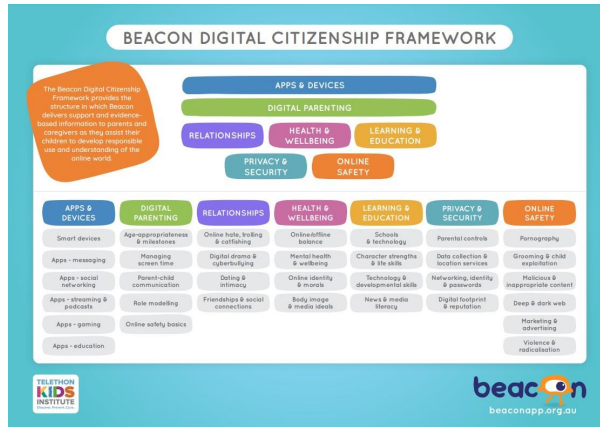

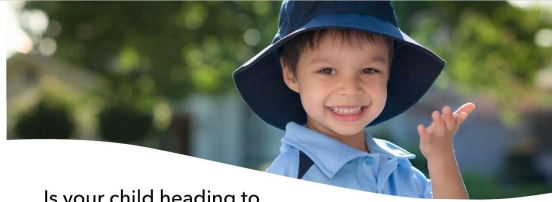
